Session One: Spider Webs

See what the fun is all about and why Jean is so passionate and has made dozens and dozens of variations of spider webs. It's quick, accurate, easy and addictive. After making your first "web" - you can turn it into a pillow with a decorator zipper - or... continue on and make any size quilt you like. Kits will be available.



Session Two: Option A: Garden Party

This makes a great pillow, wall hanging, or even a special border around a quilt. Using Jean's "reckless and raw edge technique" we will be free-motion-quilting within hours.



Session Two: Option B: My Alaska Adventure

Specifically designed for this cruise paying honor to the Alaskan flag with its stars as well as the Bald Eagle. Our stars will be fun to make and can even be made in a liberated style. Make it with all the same size blocks shown in Alaskan Flag colors, Aurora Borealis-style color, or make up your own. Blocks can be large and modern, or varied sizes as shown pattern will be provided for the medallion of the bald eagle which will be fused together to form the center of our quilt.
