She has designed 23 patterns and written one resource manual called Patchwork Math. Lynn has been the featured artist for several quilt shows including "The Quilt Show" and has designed quilts for fabric manufacturers. Lynn has had several quilts offered in Keepsake Quilting Catalogs. She enjoys designing and making traditional quilts, combining her love of appliqué with pieced blocks.

Session One: Finessing the Figures

This is a 'hands-on' class where you will be learning the formulas and techniques for the most common quilting components found in traditional blocks, sashings or borders. You will learn how to make components 4 or 8 at a time to speed the process. I will take the fear, anxiety, and mental gymnastics out of quilting math. You will become empowered, and learn how to create and design your own blocks, sashings and borders by applying the principles and techniques learned in class in a fun, relaxing, and educational atmosphere. We will learn how to make this attractive block the first day of class. By day two, you will be ready to tackle a traditional sampler quilt if you wish. You will be flying.....or in this case sailing to new heights to achieve precision quilting while working with color. You will never be afraid of quilting math again!
